Artist's Biography

Ken Goldmann received his degree in fine art from Yale University. Early in his career, while working for a decorative wood carving company in Syracuse, New York, Ken spent his break time watching the talented European woodcarvers at work, carving intricate designs, some for use in Victorian homes.

Goldman and his wife moved to California in 1970. Shortly after moving, Ken began teaching sculpting and wood carving throughout the southland. He had his first solo gallery show in Pasadena. Today Ken's work can be seen at galleries and museums throughout the U.S.

Ken's method of working is unique. He does not necessarily start a sculpture with a planned design. Instead, Ken likes to work intuitively, looking to the wood for inspiration and direction. This method helps to reveal the essence of the wood.

Goldman's inspiring work is diverse in subject matter as well as style, conveying emotion and affecting the viewer. His sculptures can be found in many private and corporate collections worldwide.
